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How to Use

For Fresh Stains:

3. **Apply Liberally:** Squeeze Miss Mouth's directly onto the stain
4. **Work In:** Gently work the product into the fabric using your fingers or a soft brush
5. **Wait:** Allow the product to sit for 1-5 minutes
6. **Rinse:** Rinse with cold water if treating immediately

For Set-In Stains:

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Storage Instructions

- Store in a cool, dry place

 - Do not freeze
 - Product shelf life: 3 years from manufacture date

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Troubleshooting

Stain Didn't Come Out Completely:

- Reapply Miss Mouth's and let sit longer
- Try the soaking method for stubborn stains
- Some very old stains may require multiple treatments
- Avoid using hot water on protein-based stains initially

Fabric Discoloration:

- Always test on hidden area first
- Some fabrics may be sensitive to any stain remover
